
2. To develop professional skills and competences in areas such as project management, project application writing, organizing events, graphic designing, social media & web-page administration;

I.Project management and project assistance with ongoing and annual projects of ICPI. Volunteers will be actively involved in planning and organizing of local and international projects.

2. Volunteers will have the chance to gain the knowledge and experience to organize Erasmus + projects (TC, YE) with local coordinator of Erasmus+; They will learn to write applications, to communicate with project partners, to implement project itself.

3. Working on visibility and promotion of ICPI -Volunteers will assist staff of ICPI with web development and PR activities of the organization. All activities will be evaluated regularly to find out how the content complies with participants learning goals and if any adjustments in the daily activities are needed. The participants will be encouraged to propose their own activities or ways to get involved in order to use fully their potential and develop it the desired way.

- 5. Empowering Georgian youngsters and elderly people Volunteers with Local interns will plan and organize workshops/seminars for youngsters and elderly people in different regions twice a month.
- 6. Volunteers will also have an opportunity to create and lead projects in their fields of interest. If it will be needed there will be interns from ICPI staff being in charge with them to support with Organizational part (language barrier, communicating with local media). Volunteers are free to choose the topic of their personal project and work on it during all the service or plan it in one particular month.
- 7. Weekly activities of Generator 9.8 ICPI has its own social enterprise Generator 9.8 and we are ready to involve our participants in this project as well, they will be assisted by the local volunteers and they will get support from coordinator/ex-EVS volunteers, having experience in the field.
- 8. Outdoor Activities ICPI has been organizing various outdoor activities in different regions of Georgia. Volunteers will have opportunity to be actively invovled in organizing and implementation.
