



WHAT IS IT ABOUT?


The project **ESCAPE FAKE NEWS** is a two-staged international training course that introduces fact-checking techniques, revealing fake news and gamification in non-formal education.

The venue is in a small town Horka nad Moravou located about 7 km northwest of Olomouc. This place also functions as a centre for ecological activities, whose ambition is to create opportunities to spend time actively in nature.



ARRIVAL TO ACCOMMODATION


How to get from the Olomouc train station to Horka nad Moravou:

The easiest option is to take tram 7 or tram X1/4 from the main train station (the tram stop is right in front of the main entrance), and take 3 stops to Tržnice. From there, bus 18 departs and takes you to Horka, škola station. The journey should take about half an hour.

From the Horka bus stop it is about 8 minutes on foot to our accommodation.


Collect and keep all invoices, tickets, boarding passes to be eligable for reimbursement.

The **participation fee** is 50 EUR. The fee will be paid on each stage in cash.




WEATHER AND WHAT TO BRING

November in the Czech Republic is a month with very changeable and typically autumn weather. The highest daytime temperatures in November average around 6 to 10 °C, with nighttime temperatures ranging from 2 to 4 °C, so be sure to pack warm enough clothing to be prepared even for outdoor activities.



DON'T FORGET TO PACK:

- Passport/ID card
- Original boarding passes/tickets
- Travel and health insurance (or European Health Insurance Card)
- Watter bottle
- Indoor shoes
- Raincoat
- Towels, hygiene care
- Medicine that you use or might need
- Food, drinks, flags, everything for your international coffee breaks
- At least one tablet/notebook per international group





INTERNATIONAL COFFEE Breaks

Each national group will present their country and prepare one coffee break where you can share your typical food, snacks and drinks with others.

You can also sing a song, dance traditional dance, explain traditions, etc. over a cup of coffee or tea.
