




PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

ACCOMMODATION



1ST STAGE

The 1st stage of the project will take place in the Czech Republic in <u>Kubasův mlýn</u>, located in a small village in the foothills of the Orlické Mountains.

2ND STAGE

The 2nd stage of the project will take place in Adrasan, Turkey. We will share more information after the 1st stage.



INTERCULTURAL EVENING

There will be one intercultural evening during the project where each national group will have the opportunity to present their country. You can share your typical food, snacks, and drinks with others and showcase your culture through songs, traditional dances, or by explaining your customs and traditions. This will be a great chance to connect with everyone and experience a variety of cultures in one evening!

30 EUR will be used for the local transportation in the Czech Republic - these are already deducted from the travel budget.

Accommodation, transport, and meals are fully covered by Erasmus+.

You may take up to 2 extra days before/after the project, but all costs during those days are at your own expense.

REMEMBER!

- Send us a proposal of your tickets before buying them. It is necessary that we will APPROVE them first!
- Keep invoices of the purchases and boarding passes and tickets so we can reimburse them for you.
- Only the cheapest and most direct way of transport will be reimbursed and only under the condition that the participant will take part in the whole project.
- It is necessary for the participants to have **travel health insurance** (this is not covered by the project).

ARRIVAL TO ACOMODATION

The meeting point will be in front of the main train station in **Ústí nad Orlicí** by the green glass entrance into the building on **September 10, 2025** between **4 and 6 pm**.





The **participation fee is 50 EUR / 1 250 CZK**. The fee will be paid on each stage in cash.


WEATHER AND WHAT TO BRING

September in the Czech Republic is a month with mild and pleasant early autumn weather. The highest daytime temperatures in September average around 18 to 22 °C, with nighttime temperatures ranging from 8 to 12 °C, so be sure to pack layers to stay comfortable, especially for outdoor activities.
